Introduction for Abstract Submission

1. The Official language is English.
2. An abstract body of up to 300 words (Font: century, 10.5pt) and a title of up to 20 words (Font: century 12pt) may be submitted. Do not insert any tables or figures in the body. Please note also that neither the body nor the title will register if they exceed their character limit.
3. Give us the title of the E-mail as [IAHM2008tokyo Paper Application]. Summarize the abstract in one piece of A4 size, and attach it with the file of the MS word form. And specify your full name, position, address, phone number, and e-mail address.
4. Once your application has been received, you will be notified by e-mail automatically. If no contact has been received after 7 days, please contact the conference secretariat.

Style of Presentation

You must present your paper in poster form as a general rule. The organizing committee may ask you for the change of the presentation form.

Topics

Free, but a matter about Humanitarian Medicine.

Abstract Review and Selection

Abstracts will be reviewed and selected by the organizing committee.

Confirmation of acceptance or rejection of abstracts is scheduled to be sent out by e-mail to presenting authors by end of November 2007.
